And the life expectancy of your new PnF coated pool is largely the result of how well it's maintained. This includes keeping it clean above and below the waterline (brooming walls / floors to remove any chemical residues, leaves and algae, weekly in summer and monthly in winter), and making sure the pool water is checked by the pool shop (weekly in summer and monthly in winter), and the chemistry adjusted as needed to keep it healthy and in specification. Then your new PnF Coated Pool will last a lot longer and look a lot better than if these basic undertakings are ignored partially or completely.
