What Is Pebblecrete?



Pebblecrete is a cement and natural stone mixture trowelled over concrete and washed back to expose the small pebbles. Available in standard, mini, and polished pebble.

Appearance & Features

- Natural, earthy, lagoon-style look
- Slightly textured finish
- Excellent traction underfoot
- Huge range of stone blends and colours

Pros

- **Extremely durable** — one of the longest-lasting surfaces
- Handles harsh Aussie climate well
- Very low porosity compared with Marblesheen
- Lifespan **20–30+ years** with balanced water
- Resistant to staining
- Modern polished pebble options feel much smoother

Cons

- Standard pebble can feel rough for sensitive feet
- Medium to high installation cost
- Repairs, while possible, may be visible
- Can trap dirt if water circulation is poor
- Requires more chemicals to keep clean and algae free
- Pool acid tends to eat the cement away, making rough surface

Chemical Sensitivity

Pebblecrete is far more forgiving than plaster-style surfaces but still benefits from good LSI control to prevent scale or etching.

Repair, Upgrade or Replace

- Patches possible but visible
- Entire surface can be overlaid with new pebble or quartz
- Can be upgraded to tiles for a premium finish
- Can also be upgraded with an epoxy or fluoropolymer paint

Ideal For

Aussie families, high-use pools, and anyone wanting a long-lasting, low-maintenance interior that copes well with summer heat.

It can be upgraded to provide smoother and easier to keep clean surface. (Epoxy or Fluoropolymer)
