Testing Your Pool Water Balance

Before testing, it's important to

1, check the expiration date of your reagents to ensure accuracy.

2, familiarise yourself with your test kit.

Notice how the bottles are colour-coded and arranged in sequence to match the instructions.

3, always refer to your kit's specific instructions for the best results.

Proper water sampling is the basis for accurate testing. Submerge your comparator or collection tube elbow deep into the water, away from return lines, and fill it to the level indicated in your kit's instructions.

For reliable results, make sure your test water is always between 10 and 32°C.

Taylor test kits require using different testing methods depending on what's being measured.

To read your results, hold the comparator at eye level in natural light, preferably against the sky. Match the colour of the sample to the provided colour standards to determine the levels in your water.

To prolong the life of your test kit, store it in a cool, dark place away from direct sunlight and chemicals.
