What Are Vinyl Liners?

Vinyl liners are flexible PVC membranes fitted into a track around the pool's coping. They're common in renovations of older concrete or fibreglass pools.

Appearance & Features

- Smooth, soft feel
- Printed patterns available (tile bands, blue mosaics, etc.)
- Clean, bright water colour

Pros

- Lowest upfront cost for most renovations
- Quick installation
- Very smooth — gentle for kids
- Easy patch repairs for small tears
- Good short-term solution for structurally sound old pools

Cons

- Shorter lifespan: **7–12 years**
- Can tear from sharp objects or pets
- Patterns can fade over time
- Not suitable for pools with significant structural movement

Chemical Sensitivity

High chlorine or unstabilised water can bleach the liner. pH swings can cause wrinkling.

Repair, Upgrade or Replace

- Patch small tears
- Replace entire liner when ageing
- Upgrade options: fibreglass lining or pebble/quartz

Budget-conscious owners wanting a quick, clean-looking renovation.
